On the 91st anniversary of Persons Day, the day women were recognized as persons under the law in Canada, Alberta Women's Advocacy Association are proud to announce their launch!

Alberta Women's Advocacy Association (AWAA) are a female-centered, female-run non-profit dedicated to advocating for women's sex-based rights and protections in Alberta and nationwide.

As a secular, non-partisan coalition of women, AWAA have three goals: first, to lobby representatives in municipal, provincial, and federal governments to protect and advocate for the support of the health, safety, and rights of women and girls; second, to be a useful resource for evidence-based information on sex-specific issues, and; third, to provide support to Albertan women and girls through community outreach. AWAA believe that women can achieve the ultimate goal of ending sex-based oppression when they work together.

AWAA started when a group of women sat down together in frustration over how gender identity ideology has affected the lives of women and girls across the country. The conclusion reached through their conversations was that the best way to be advocated for was to be the ones doing the advocating. AWAA are looking forward to working with charities, local organisations and companies, and community initiatives to make groundbreaking change!
